2016 ANNUAL REPORT

In the Headlines...

- East Tawas opened their new 5,000 sq. ft. library in August. This beautiful facility offers more space and opportunities for the community.
- Five branches benefitted from District grants that helped them make the following improvements:

~AuGres replaced the flooring in the vestibule, added LED lighting in the parking lot and purchased new tables and chairs.

~The Omer Little Eagles Nest Library installed a new LED "Open" sign and purchased a new storage cabinet.

~Plainfield painted, recarpeted and updated the electrical in their library.

~East Tawas put their grant money toward the purchase of furniture for their new facility.

~Whittemore repaired their roof, replaced a door and awning, and installed new tile in the restroom.



More Headlines

- The Standish Library received a much appreciated 2% Grant from the Chippewa Tribe which paid for a new roof on the library.
- The District added Author Alerts as a new service. This allows patrons to go online and enter their favorite authors. They receive an email when new books by these authors are available at the library.
- Public Internet computers were used 29,733 times and there were 39,948 logins by patrons on their own laptops/devices using District provided WiFi.
- There were over 12,700 digital books, audiobooks, magazines, music and movies checked out using Overdrive, Zinio and Hoopla
- Branch library staff issued 1,355 new cards in 2016.
- District branch libraries were open to patrons for 16,392 hours.
- Headquarters staff added 10,382 new books, CD books and magazine subscriptions to the District collection, spending \$144,557.
- The District shared \$409,322 of the millage funds with local units of government to support branch library operations.
- Library staff recorded 129,697 patron visits and checked out over 116,208 books, audios, videos and magazines using our automated system.

A new service is now available to Iosco-Arenac District Library patrons. Hoopla allows patrons to instantly borrow digital movies, music, ebooks, audiobooks, comics and TV shows, 24/7 with their library card. With no waiting, titles can be streamed immediately, or downloaded to computers, phones or tablets for offline enjoyment later. There are hundreds of thousands of titles to choose from, with more being added daily. Movies and music can be checked out for 72 hours while ebooks and audiobooks have a three-week time limit. And the best part is that there are never any overdue fees!



Programs for Kids...

- ✍ Over 162 programs attracted more than 2,900 children and teens, as well as 1,263 adults.
- ✍ Staycation Fun kept kids entertained during spring break. They made beautiful Butterfly Shadowboxes, watched live raptors in awe, sang along with Kevin Devine and were mystified by the Amazing Clark.
- ✍ The 2016 Summer Reading Club theme was "On Your Mark, Get Set, Read!". There were 37 programs that included Cirque Amongus, Animals from Around the World, Magician Alan Kazam, Wings of Wonder, and much more.....
- ✍ In cooperation with the MSU Extension and 4H, kids had the opportunity to build robotics at Lego & K'nex Robotics Makerspace programs.
- ✍ Storyteller, Jenifer Strauss, made kids laugh and shiver (sometimes at the same time) with her "Tingling Tales" Halloween programs.
